

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 314

WHEREAS, Thomas Childs has made the attached offer to deed to the United States in trust for the Papago Tribe certain lands and improvements, subject of a life interest in the property, and other conditions, and

WHEREAS, It is greatly to the interest of the Papago Tribe to take advantage of this generous offer,

WHEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Papago Council that the attached offer to Sell Lands to the United States, including the conditions therein, be accepted.

The foregoing resolution was on April 4, 1947, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
