WHEREAS, Section IV, (b) of Ordinance #10 of the Papago Council provides that the Chairman and Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council shall be members of the Papago Livestock Board during their terms of office, and

WHEREAS, Section IV, (c) of the same Ordinance provides, among other things, that the Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council shall act as Secretary, and Treasurer of the Papago Livestock Board, and

THEREAS, The Papago Council now feels that their Chairman and Secretary and Treasurer are too busy with Tribal business to spare time for the necessary Livestock Board work, and that their place should be taken by persons whose interests are solely with livestock,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Papago Council that Section IV, (b) of Ordinance #10 be smended to read as follows:

The Papago Livestock Board shall consist of five members appointed by a majority vote of the Tribal Council, and shall serve for terms of three years or until their successors have been appointed and qualified; provided, however, that the three members who were formerly members of the Papago Tribal herd Board and who are presently serving as members of the Papago Livestock Board shall continue in office for terms of one, two and three years respectively from the first Saturday in July 1943, or until their successors have been appointed and qualified, the length of the term of each to be determined by the Papago Tribal Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Section IV, (c) of Ordinance #10 be amended to read as follows:

and Secretary-Treasurer, who shall be selected by the members of the Papago Livestock Board from within its own membership at the annual meeting of the Board which is to be held on the first Saturday of July in each year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Section IV, (d) of the same ordinance beamended to read as follows:

"Members of the Papago Livestock Board shall be eligible for reappointment. No such member of the Board shall be removed during his term of office so long as he functions in the best interests of the Papago Tribe but any such member of the Board may be removed for cause by a majority vote of the Papago Council."
