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RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 318

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did, through Ordinance #4, Section #2 regulate the Management of The Papago Fair and Rodeo Association, and

WHEREAS, It has been found that this ordinance does not provide sufficient number of members to properly manage this organization,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Ordinance #4, Section #2, Management be amended in part as follows:

"The affairs of the association shall be managed by a Board of Directors, composed of 9 members of the tribe, who shall be appointed by The Papago Council to serve during good behavior."

The foregoing resolution was on May 16, 1947, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1 and Section 2 (m), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
