The foregoing resolution was on June 20, 1947, duly enacted by a vote of 12 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1930, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 10, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
