RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL



WHEREAS, The fund PT-4, Salaries of Tribal Employees, 1947 is overexpended in the amount of \$27.14 because of lump sum payment to Jose C. Narcho, Janitor, who was terminated at the close of business June 30, 1947, not considered in the 1947 Budget,

THEREFORE, Be it resolved by The Papago Council that the sum of \$27.14 be transferred from PT-7 Papago Tribe, Emergency Fund, 1947 to PT-4 Papago Tribe, Salaries of Tribal Employees, 1947 to cover this deficit.

The foregoing Resolution was on September 5, 1947, duly enacted by a vote __against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, Pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
