RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 333

WHEREAS, The cost of repairing and improving the Papago Tribal Community Building has been greater than anticipated, due to the increased cost of materials purchased, and

WHEREAS, The \$500.00 provided for this purpose in the fund PT-6 Papago Tribe, Maintenance, Repairs, and Improvements to Tribal Community Building in the 1948 Budget, Resolution No. 320, dated June 20, 1947 was insufficient,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by The Papago Council that the sum of \$350.00 be transferred from the fund PT-7 Papago Tribe, Miscellaneous Fund to the fund PT-6 Papago Tribe, Maintenance, Repairs, and Improvements to Tribal Community Building to be used as provided under that section of the Fiscal Year 1948 Budget.

The foregoing resolution was on October 31, 1947 duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 15 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article v of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
