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FEDERAL BUREAU OF INVESTIGATION
U.S. DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE

No. 334

WHEREAS, The center section of the grand stand for the rodeo field was destroyed by fire, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Fair and Rodeo Board has estimated a cost of \$1,000.00 for rebuilding the section aforementioned;

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Tribal Council that an expenditure of not to exceed \$1,000.00 be authorized for payment of labor and the purchase of materials necessary for rebuilding said center section of the grand stand;

PROVIDED, That such expenditures for labor and materials be under the direction and supervision of the rodeo committee and the Engineering Division of the Papago Agency,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That we authorize the expenditure of not to exceed \$1,000.00 from the Fund PT-1 Papago Tribe, General Fund for such labor and materials as may be necessary in accordance with the estimate submitted.

The foregoing resolution was on October 31, 1947 duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
