

RESOLUTION

THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 336

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 14 of the Papago Council required the approval of the Council of the issuance of Tribal Business Licenses, and

WHEREAS, The Trader's Committee of The Papago Council has considered the applications for traders licenses, and has made recommendations to the Council concerning them,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by The Papago Council that traders licenses be approved and upon payment of the proper fees, issued to the following applicants for the Fiscal Year 1948:

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1947 duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 9 (e), of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, Pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
