

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

EW: 337

WHEREAS, Dr. M. K. Mirran has been of great service to the Papago people as physician at San Xavier Sanitarium, showing himself interested in our problems and ever ready to help us; and

WHEREAS, It has come to the attention of the Papago Council that Dr. M.K. Mirran is to be transferred from San Xavier,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by The Papago Council that the Chairman of the Council be instructed to transmit to the Commissioner of Indian Affairs a petition requesting that Dr. M.K. Mirran be retained at San Xavier Sanitarium.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1947 duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (1), of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 954). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
