WHEREAS, Juan Jose, an Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Court, has shown himself to be unworthy of that position,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the Commissioner of Indian Affairs be requested to remove said Juan Jose from his position as Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Court.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1947 duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (b), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Salls Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
