

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 340

WHEREAS, Osborne's Trading Post is occupying certain buildings on the Tierney and Steinfeld Tract that are held in trust by the United States of America for the Papago Tribe of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The Superintendent of the Papago Agency has indicated that these buildings will not be needed by the United States for its own use, for a period of five years or more, and

WHEREAS, The Trader's Committee of the Papago Council has drawn up a lease of these buildings to Osborne's Trading Post which meets with the approval of the Council, and of the Superintendent of the Papago Agency,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the attached lease between the Papago Tribe and Osborne's Trading Post be approved, and that the Chairman of the Papago Council be instructed to sign this lease on behalf of the Papago Tribe of Arizona, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the monies accruing from this lease be deposited in the fund Papago Tribe, General Fund PT-1.

The foregoing resolution was on December 5, 1947 duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (h) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.-
