

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 341

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 15 of the Papago Council requires that the use of an assignment of a member of the Papago Tribe by a non-member be approved by the Council, and

WHEREAS, Mariano Johnson has applied to the Council for permission to lease to O. W. Huish a portion of his assignment of Tribal Land at Sells for use as a trading post,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Mariano Johnson be given permission to rent to O. W. Huish the portion of his assignment at Sells shown on the attached map.

PROVIDED, That should said O. W. Huish sell his business, Mariano Johnson shall have permission to rent to the new trader, after said new trader has complied with the regulations of the Council.

The foregoing resolution was on December 19, 1948 duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (d) Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Sells Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and by-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
