RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 351

WHEREAS, That an error was made in phraseology in Ordinance #15,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, Wherever the word (Assignment) is used, referring to permission to use land by nonmembers of the tribe, the word (Lease) be substituted.

The foregoing resolution was on February 6, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and O against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 4, of Article VIII, of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
