RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 352

WHEREAS, There are potential irrigable lands on the Gila Bend Indian Reservation of little grazing valve to the Papago people, and

WHEREAS, The opportunity has arisen to lease certain of these lands under an irrigation development lease, and

WHEREAS, This would be of great benefit to the Papago people,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Tribal Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized on behalf of the Papago Tribe be enter into an irrigation development lease with E.L. Scisson for all of Section 7 T 5 S.R. 5W. and the W1/2 SW 1/4 S17 T5 S R 5W, G&S R B& M, containing 720 acres more or less for a period of ten years beginning January 1, 1949.

PROVIDED, That one half of the proceeds of such lease be paid into the General Fund of the Papago Tribe, and one half to be deposited to the credit of Gila Bend District to be spent under the regulations of the Papago Council.

The foreging resolution was on February 20, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (d) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, Pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
