

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 357

WHEREAS, The superintendent of Papago Agency was authorized last June, 1947 to place an order with the Treasury Department for a pickup truck for the use of the Tribal Office, and

WHEREAS, This pickup has now been purchased and received,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that payment for said truck and all operating expenses be payable from the Miscellaneous fund, PT-7, Fiscal Year 1948.

The foregoing resolution was on March 12, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested it by Section 3 (a), of Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
