

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 360

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 14 of the Papago Council requires the approval of the Council of the issuance of tribal business licenses, and

WHEREAS, The Traders Committee of the Papago Council has considered the applications for peddlers licenses and has made recommendations to the Council concerning them,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that peddlers licenses be approved and upon payment of the proper fees, issued to the following applicants for the following periods:

Tracy's Trading Post	March 25, 1948 to May 24, 1948
Covered Wells Trading Post	March 24, 1948 to May 25, 1948
James Robinett	March 27, 1948 to May 26, 1948
Cababi Trading Post	March 12, 1948 to May 12, 1948

The foregoing resolution was on March 12, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 17 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago
