

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 362

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 14 of the Papago Council requires the approval of the Council of the issuance of Tribal business licenses, and

WHEREAS, The Traders Committee of the Papago Council has considered the applications for peddlers licenses and has made recommendations to the Council concerning them,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY the Papago Council that peddlers licenses be approved and upon payment of the proper fees, issued to the following applicants for the following periods:

James Robinette, Peddler	May 27, 1948 to June 27, 1948
E. S. Robinette, Peddler	May 6, 1948 to June 27, 1948
Swell Time Ice Cream Corp.	May 10, 1948 to June 9, 1948

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
