

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. .363

WHEREAS, There has long been a need for protecting the Papago Livestock Industry and for complying with the Arizona State Law by the provision of adequate documents covering livestock inspection and sales from the Papago reservations, and

WHEREAS, Such sample forms as are required have been drawn up, and met with approval,

NOW THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the printing of official "Certificates of Sale and Brand Inspection" and "Bills of Sale" be authorized, and that their use be compulsory for all sales of livestock by members of the Papago Tribes from the Papago reservations, such forms to be procured as necessary by the Chairman of the Papago Council,

PROVIDED, That the cost of printing these forms be defrayed from the fund PT-10, Papago Tribe Tax Collections from Livestock Sales, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the "Bill of Sale" forms be made available for sale by the Treasurer of the Papago Council at a price set by the Council, and the proceeds deposited in I. I. M. Account PT-10.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec 3 (a) and (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, Pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
