

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 364

WHEREAS, Louis Harvey's appointment as Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Court expired March 1, 1948,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Louis Harvey of Sells District be recommended to the Secretary of the Interior for reappointment to the position of Associate Judge of the Papago Tribal Court.

The foregoing resolution was on May 7, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (b) of Article V, and Article VII of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, Pursuant to Section 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
