

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 367

WHEREAS, The Indian Service has presented to the Papago Tribe the opportunity of entering actively into the Repayment Cattle Program under contract to the Federal Government, and

WHEREAS, This is a proposal worthy of careful and serious consideration,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that the Livestock Committee investigate the proposal and make recommendations thereon to the Council, considering in particular outstanding contracts of individual Indians with the Federal Government, a plan of operation of the proposed Papago Tribal Repayment Cattle Enterprise, and a contract between the Papago Tribe and the Federal Government along the proposed lines.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Papago Council and the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be requested to notify the Indian Office of the interest of the Papago Tribe in this proposal, and to request of the Indian Office sufficient time to consider it and make a decision thereupon.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior Pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
