PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has learned with sincere regret of the passing of Sidney P. Osborne, Governor of the State of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, Sidney P. Osborne had always shown an active and sympathetic interest in the special problems of the Papago Tribe of Arizona and in our people, so that we looked upon him as our true friend,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council, that we express to Mrs. Sidney P. Osborne our heartfelt sympathy in her loss, which is our loss also.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
