

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 359

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 366 of the Papago Council provides that Committee members shall be paid for attendance at Committee and at Council meetings, but makes no mention of the source of such expenditures,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that subsistence and travel expenses for the committee set up under Resolution No. 366 shall be paid from the fund I.L.M. Account PT-7, Miscellaneous Fund, under authorizations of the Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council, approved by the Chairman of the Committee involved.

The foregoing resolution was on May 25, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Section 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
