WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe through its Council are preparing a long range plan for Papago Rehabilitation, and

WHEREAS, The future of the Papagos depends to a large extent on the plan and its provisions, and

WHEREAS, The success of the plan depends upon Congressional action through legislation and appropriations, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Tribe feel that their own members and representatives can best explain and justify the plan to the <sup>C</sup>ongress.

NOW, THERE FORE, HE IT RESOLVED by the <sup>P</sup>apago Council that during the Fiscal Year 1949 the Council authorize a delegation consisting of three members of the Tribe to go to Washington, D. C. for the propose of presenting this plan, and -

E IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Papago Council request an appropriation from its trust funds on deposit in the United States Treasury in the amount of \$1,000. This appropriation and allotment is requested from the fund, "14X7771.205 Interest and Accruals on Interest, Proceeds of Labor, Papago Indians, Sells, Arizona - Papago Agency (Tribal Councils, 1949)." This fund will be available for payment of expenses of the Papago delegation on the Washington prip.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the <sup>P</sup>apago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Soc. 3 (a) of <sup>A</sup>rticle <sup>V</sup> of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on <sup>D</sup>ecember 12, 1936, and approved by the <sup>S</sup>ecretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago <sup>A</sup>gency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pusuant to Sec. 6, <sup>A</sup>rticle <sup>V</sup>, of the <sup>C</sup>onstitution and By-Laws of th/ePapago Tribe.
