

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 373

WHEREAS, Lorentine Joaquin was by Resolution #319 appointed to the position of Caretaker-Jailer for a two-year period beginning July 1, 1947 and ending June 30, 1949, unless sooner terminated by the Papago Council, and

WHEREAS, Lorentine Joaquin has shown himself worthy of the responsibilities placed upon him and has concientiously carried out his duties,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the salary of the Caretaker-Jailer be raised from \$100.00 per month to \$125.00 per month, effective July 1, 1948 and payable in accordance with Paragraph 4 of Resolution No. 319.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) and (b) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior Pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
