

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 360

WHEREAS, The Papago Fair and Rodeo Association has set aside Saturday October 30, and Sunday October 31, 1948 for their Annual Papago Indian Rodeo and Arts and Crafts Exhibition,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council;

- (1) That a fitting program be arranged in connection with the Rodeo and Arts and Crafts Exhibition.
- (2) That the Chairman of the Papago Council be instructed to issue invitations to official guests of the Tribe.
- (3) That the Chairman be authorized to use two beefs from the Papago Tribal Herd for a barbeque.
- (4) That the Papago People be invited to participate actively in the celebration.

The foregoing resolution was on September 17, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 1, of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
