

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 386

WHEREAS, The Papago Council is greatly interested in the continuance of its annual Fair and Rodeo, and

WHEREAS, It has become necessary that certain improvements be made to further this cause,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that loan of \$1,000.00 be granted from the fund "I.I.M. Account No. PT-11, Papago Loan Fund" to the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association, without interest, and repayable in equal annual installments, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Treasurer of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association be directed to deposit with the Loan Board Manager from any of said Association Funds in said Treasurer's possession, for credit to the fund "I.I.M. Account No. PT-11, Papago Loan Fund," the sum of \$200.00 on the second day of January, 1949, and a like amount on the second day of January each year thereafter until the full sum of \$1,000.00 herein loaned shall have been repaid, and

PROVIDED, That the specified amount of \$200.00 shall not be construed as a limiting factor in the event larger payments can be made, and

PROVIDED FINALLY, That all existing debts of the Fair and Rodeo Association now due the Papago Loan Fund shall have been liquidated prior to the advancement of this loan.

The foregoing resolution was on September 24, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), of Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
