RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 287

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 14 of the Papago Council requires the approval of the Council of the issuance of Tribal Business Licenses, and

WHEREAS, The Traders Committee of The Papago Council has considered the application for a Traders License, and has made recommendations to the Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by The Papago Council that a traders license be approved and upon payment of the proper fees, issued to Raymond Moristo for operating a restaurant for the balance of Fiscal Year 1949.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1948 duly enacted by the Papago Council by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 904). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
