NOW, YMERSFURE, Be It Resolved by The Papago Council that a traders license be approved and upon payment of the proper fees, issued to Haymond Koristo for operating a restaurant for the balance of Fiscal Tear 1949.

The foregoing resolution was on Movember 5, 1948 duly enseted by the Papago Council by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Jamesry 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (46 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Popago Tribe.
