WHEREAS, The Papago Fair and Rodeo Association held its Annual Papago Indian Rodeo and Arts and Crafts Exhibition on Saturday October 30, and Sunday October 31. 1948, and

WHEREAS, The Tucson Chamber of Commerce, the Papago Agency and many other interested people greatly assisted the Association to successfully stage their show,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the Chairman be instructed to write letters of appreciation and thanks to those individuals and groups who have contributed most.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Council send a special letter of thanks to Charlie Garcia for the invaluable services given by his wife, Angelita Garcia and that the deepest sympathies of the Papago Council be expessed to Chairlee Garcia on the passing of Angelita Garcia.

HE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman obtain from Archie Hendricks, Chairman of the Papago Fair and Rodeo Association and Ida N. Wilson, Manager Papago Arts and Crafts adequate reports on the financial status of their respective organizations.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the apago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 1, and Sec. 2(1), of Article V, of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18k 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is not subject to review by the Secretary of the Interior.
