

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 390

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 371 of the Papago Council in setting up uniform rates for the officers and members of the Papago Council, its Boards and Committees, provides "That no person shall be paid a subsistence allowance for attending more than one meeting in any one," and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did at their special meeting on July 2, 1948, unanimously vote to delete the proviso, and

WHEREAS, The whole resolution is based on the payment of a subsistence allowance \$5.00 per day for attendance at authorized meetings, and

WHEREAS, The Superintendent of the Papago Agency has already written checks in payment for attendance of more than one meeting in one day on the basis of the Council minutes of July 2, 1948, but without a supporting resolution,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the payments made during the period beginning July 2, 1948 and ending November 30, 1948 are hereby authorized and approved and are properly chargeable to I. I.M. Account PT-2 and PT-5.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 13 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
