

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 393

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 371 set up uniform rates for the officers and members of the Papago Council, its Boards and Committees based on a subsistence allowance of \$5. per day, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did at their special meeting on July 2, 1948 unanimously vote to delete the proviso "That no person shall be paid a subsistence allowance for attending more than one meeting in anyone day," and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 390 of the Papago Council merely authorizes and approves the payments made by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency for attendance of more than one meeting in one day on the basis of the Council minutes of July 2, 1948, during the period begining July 2, 1948 and ending November 30, 1948, without amending or rescinding Resolution No. 371, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by unanimous vote decided to pay its officers, members, Boards, and Committees on a per meeting basis,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Resolution No. 371 be hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on November 26, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by S. c. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
