

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 394

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 393 rescind Resolution No. 371, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council believes that uniform rates should be set up,

THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Papago Council that officers and members of the Papago Council, its Boards and Committees shall be paid at the rate of \$5.00 per meeting for attendance at authorized meetings and further, when lodging expense is incurred at meetings off the reservation, such officers and members shall be paid an additional amount of \$5.00 per day.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that mileage allowance at the rate of 5¢ per mile shall be paid officers and members of the Papago Council, its Boards and Committee for travel to and from Sells from their places of residence.

PROVIDED, That no person shall be paid more than one mileage allowance for attending one continuous series of meetings.

Be it Finally Resolved, That the above uniform rates of pay and mileage allowance shall supercede all other rates previously set up for the Papago Council, its Boards and Committees and all provisions in conflict hereto are hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on November 26, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
