

RESOLUTION  
OF THE  
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 395

WHEREAS, The Papago Council did by Resolution No. 393 rescind Resolution No. 371, and by Resolution No. 394 set up modified rates, and

WHEREAS, The conflicting phraseology in Resolution No. 374 (Budget of the Papago Council) makes it necessary to amend it,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that Budget Account PT-2 be amended to read, "For travel expenses, and pay allowance for delegates and officers of the Papago Council in attending regular and special meetings of the Council, whether or not there be a quorum, to be expended under authorization of the Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council."

PROVIDED, That only mileage allowance be paid when there is no quorum present, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Budget Account PT-5 be amended to read, "For travel expenses and pay allowances for Council committees and officers of the Papago Council in attending committee meetings, conferences, and such meetings other than Tribal Council meetings as it may be necessary for them to attend in the performance of their authorized duties, to be expended under the authorization of the Secretary and Treasurer."

The foregoing resolution was on November 26, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and Onagainst, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-laws of the Papago Tribe.
