

RESOLUTION
OF THE
PAPAGO COUNCIL

RES. NO. 396

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 14 of the Papago Council requires the approval of the Council of the issuance of Tribal business licenses, and

WHEREAS, The Traders Committee of the Papago Council has considered the application for peddlers license of Mr. J. M. Richmond and has made recommendation to the Council,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Papago Council that peddlers license be approved and upon payment of the proper fee, issued to Mr. J. M. Richmond, for a period of one month.

The foregoing resolution was on November 26, 1948, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
