WHEREAS, the Nation Congress of American Indians is presenting and the American Friends Service Committee Fellowship of Reconciliation is sponsoring the SOUTHWEST INDIAN CONFERENCE, April 5, 6 and 7, 1949, in Phoenix, Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Council has been invited to participate and feels that much can be gained from the conference and that a real opportunity is being afforded the Council to publicize the problems of its people.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that, Edchard Hendricks, Louis Harvey, Alfred C. Garcia, Mark Menuel, Micardo Manuel, Jos A. Lopez and Thomas A. Segundo, are hereby appointed to represent the Papago Council at the conference in Phoenix, Arizona,

PROVIDED, That the pay and lodging allowances of the delegation be authorized and approved in accordance with Resolutions No. 394 and 395 of the Parago Council, and advanced prior to the delegation's departure.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and O against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article Y, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papage Gribe.
