WHAMSAS, The Papago Council in accordance with Resolution Fo. 224 employed Alfred C. Garcia, as Managor of the Fapago Loan Board, effective Johnny 12, 1948, with the understanding that after he has served for a period of one year the Council may recommend to the Commercial Department of Haskell Institute that he be awarded a certificate of graduation, if it so desires, and

THEMENS, Alfred C. Gercia, has now served the necessary period and the Papago Council feels that he has served well and made such improvement in the work at hand and feels that he will continue to improve in his work,

THEMETORE, HE IT TENDLY D, By the Papago Council that we hereby recommend to the Commercial School of Maskell Institute that Alfred C. Garcia, be awarded a diploma from said school, and

BE IT PURTHER RESILVED, That the Chairman of the Papago Council be instructed to convey the wisher of the Papago Council to Ers. Louise Baker, Read, Commercial Department, Baskell Institute.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1949, duly enseted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Popago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on Lanuary 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the resolution by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, article V, of the Constitution and By-Laus of the Papago Pribe.
