

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 402

WHEREAS, The Papago Council in accordance with Resolution No. 224, employed Alfred C. Garcia, as Manager of the Papago Loan Board, effective January 12, 1948, with the understanding that after he has served for a period of one year the Council may recommend to the Commercial Department of Haskell Institute that he be awarded a certificate of graduation, if it so desires, and

WHEREAS, Alfred C. Garcia, has now served the necessary period and the Papago Council feels that he has served well and made such improvement in his work at hand and feels that he will continue to improve in his work,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that we hereby recommend to the Commercial School of Haskell Institute that Alfred C. Garcia, be awarded a diploma from said school, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Chairman of the Papago Council be instructed to convey the wishes of the Papago Council to Mrs. Louise Baker, Head, Commercial Department, Haskell Institute.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (c), article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
