

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 403

WHEREAS, It now appears that the balance of FT-3 will not be sufficient to cover the contemplated expenses for the remainder of the fiscal year, and

WHEREAS, FT- 7 (Miscellaneous Fund) has been little used by the Papago Council during the current year and there now remains a balance of \$2,415.96,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be requested to transfer \$415.96 from fund FT-7 to Fund FT-3.

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 924). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and by-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
