

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 404

WHEREAS, The Papago Livestock Board and the Papago Council feel that better representation of the Papago people is needed in the Board and that as many of the Districts as possible should be represented, and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 10 and amending Resolution No. 317 only provide for five members,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that that part of Resolution No. 317 which amends Section IV (b) of Ordinance No. 10 be further amended to read as follows:

"The Papago Livestock Board shall consist of nine members appointed by a majority vote of the Papago Council, and shall serve for terms of three years or until their successors have been appointed and qualified"

The foregoing resolution was on April 1, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 2 (e), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
