

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 107

WHEREAS, The approved budget for operation of the Papago Tribal Herd for the Fiscal Year 1949, beginning July 1, 1948 to June 30, 1949 provides for an operating expense of \$15,000 and an estimated income of \$15,000, and

WHEREAS, The herd is being operated within the approved budget and the income is approximately \$30,000, and

WHEREAS, There exists an urgent need for additional fencing, construction, and installation of approximately four (4) miles of pipe line and construction of water troughs and storage tanks, now

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, That the management of the Papago Tribal Herd be authorized to undertake the construction of above-named improvements and authorize an expenditure of not to exceed \$14,000 from the Papago Tribal Herd Fund, PI-9 as recommended by the Papago Livestock Board at its meeting on March 31, 1949.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe.
