WHEREAS, On December 30, 1947 the Papago Council set up the account Papago Tribo, Soldier's Remorial, FT-19 for the purpose of depositing therein the voluntary contributions of money by the Papago People, and

THEREAS, It was the decision of the Papago Council that the money deposited in account Papago Tribe, Soldier's Ecmorial, PT-19 remain therein until such a time as the erection of the Soldier's Memorial begins, at which time the Papago Council may by resolution appropriate such money to the Papago Veterans Organization for use, and

THEREAS, The Papago Veterans Organization has accumulated \$267.75 and will have more from time to time which may be deposited in the account Papago Tribe, Soldier's Hemorial, PT-19, and

CHEREAS, Word has been received that the ordered plaque for the memorial is now due and the actual erection of the memorial is expected soon and the Papago Veterans Organization has now requested that the money in account Papago Tribe, Coldier's Demorial, FT-19 be made available on request,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that the \$355.63 now deposited in account Tapago Tribe, Soldier's Remorial, PT-19 and future deposits sade therein be appropriated for the erection of the Soldier's Remorial, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Secretary and Treasurer of the Farm o Council shall enthorize all payments from this fund for the purchase of supplies, Ireight, transportation, labor, and any and all other costs incurred in connection with the project,

PROVIDED, That the charges shall be presented to the Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council by a duly appointed representative of the Papago Veteran's Organization, and

PROVIDED FIRALLY, That the Papago Council may, if it deems necessary, appropriate money from its Ceneral Fund, PT-1, in an amount sufficient to complete the erection project.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1949, only enacted by a vote of 16 for and O against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (AS Stat.984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec.6, Article V, of the Constitution and by-laws of the Papago Tribe.
