## RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

130. 1,12

WHEREAS, The Fapago Livestock Board at its regular meeting on June 2, 1949 recommended approval of an increase of the Papago Tribal Kord Budget for the Fiscal Year 1949 in the amount of \$1,500.00 in order to purchase up to 60 tons of alfalfa hay at the present low price, this hay purchase being for use during the coming Fiscal Year 1950, and

WHEREAS, It appears that considerable saving may be effected by purchase on the present market quotation of \$23.45 per ton delivered and stocked at the Tribal Hord Banch.

NOT, THEREFORE, Fa It Resolved that an increase of \$1,500.00 for the purchase of this hay be authorized for the Papago Tribal Nord budget for the Fiscal Year 1949.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1949, duly exacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it b 30c. 3 (a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
