

RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 413

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 14 of the Papago Council requires the approval of the Council of the issuance of Tribal business licenses, and

WHEREAS, The Traders Committee of the Papago Council has considered the applications for peddlers licenses and livestock buyers licenses and has made recommendations to the Council,

NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that peddlers and livestock buyers licenses be approved and upon payment of the proper fees, issued to the following applicants for the following periods:

The foregoing resolution was on June 17, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3(e) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
