

RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

NO. 414

WHEREAS, On November 25, 1944 a commitment of \$155,000 of revolving credit funds was made to the Papago Tribe of Arizona, and

WHEREAS, The commitment was on October 31, 1946 modified to provide that all advances of funds were to be subject to availability, and

WHEREAS, No advances have been made on this commitment and since such time has elapsed so as to make it necessary to revise the repayment schedule if the Tribe wished to put the loan into effect,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved that the Papago Tribe request cancellation of the Tribal loan application in the amount of \$155,000 for which funds were committed on November 25, 1944, and modified on October 31, 1946 to provide that all advances of funds were subject to availability.

The foregoing resolution was on June 3, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 16 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3(h) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934. (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
