RESOLUTION  
OF  
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL.

No. 413

WHEREAS, the position of Chief-of-Police of the Papago Jurisdiction is now vacant,  
THEREFORE, Be it resolved by the Papago Council that Espirito Adams of Cu Yo District  
be and is hereby recommended for appointment to the position of Chief-of-Police for  
the Papago Jurisdiction.

The foregoing resolution was on June 17, 1938, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and  
0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 5(b)  
of Article V and Article VII of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe  
on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937,  
pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 14, 1934, (48 Stat. 916). Said resolution  
is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency,  
and is subject to the ratification by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuant to section  
5, Article V of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
