BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PAPAGO COUNCIL, That the sum of \$14.600 be appropriated from the General Fund of the Papago Tribe, Account PT-1, for the ordinary expenses of the Papago Council for the Fiscal Year 1950, to be transferred to the accounts listed below in the amounts set forth, and to be expended as authorized therein, on and after July 1, 1949.

PROVIDED, That at the end of the Fiscal Year 1950 any unobligated balance in any of the below-listed budget accounts shall revert to the General Fund PT-1.

Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
