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RESOLUTION
OF
THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 419

WHEREAS, The Papago Loan Board Expenses have been paid from the Papago Tribal Account PT-12, and

WHEREAS, It has been necessary within the fiscal year to make numerous transfers of small amounts of this fund from Fund PT-11, and

WHEREAS, The Papago Loan Board has recommended that the Papago Council, transfer \$2,255.73, from the Fund PT-11 to Fund PT-12, to provide adequate working capital,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council, that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency be authorized to transfer \$2, 255.73, from PT-11 Papago Loan Board Fund to PT-12 Papago Loan Board Expense Fund, to provide for authorized salary and other expenses.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. (a), Article V, of the Constitution of the Papago Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 964). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
