RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

No. 430

WHEREAS, The budget for the Papago Tribal Herd for the Fiscal Year 1950 has been presented by the Papago Livestock Board to the Papago Council with the recommendation that it be approved.

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved, by the Papago Council that we authorize the expenditure from the fund PT-9, Papago Tribal Herd of the assumt budgeted and authorize the Secretary and Treasurer of the Papago Council to sign vouchers from this fund for the amounts and purposes called for in the attached budget.

PROVIDED, That the Livestock Board submit an analysis of expenditures at the end of the Fiscal Year 1950 for comparison with the 1950 budget.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1949, duly tracted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, parsuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat. 984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior, pursuent to Sec. 6, ArticleV, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
