WHEREAS, There is now only a balance of \$76.54 in Account PT-3, not sufficient to cover the expenses for the remainder of the fiscal year 1949, and


WHEREAS, Account PT-7 (Miscellaneous Fund) at the end of the fiscal year 1949, has a balance of \$1,923.51,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, By the Papago Council that the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, be requested to transfer \$200.00 from the Account PT-7 to the Account PT-3,


PROVIDED, That after the expenses for the fiscal year 1949 are paid in full, that any unobligated balance in the Account PT-3, revert back to the Account PT-1.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1949, duly enacted by a vote of 14 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Section 3(a), Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 13, 1934, (48 Stat. 934). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of the Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Article V, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Papago Tribe.
