RESOLUTION OF THE PAPAGO COUNCIL

WHEREAS, It is for the best interest of the Papago People that more and better services be made available in the livestock buying operations, and

WHEREAS, At the present time all of the Livestock Inspectors on the Papago reservations are Indian Service employees with other duties to perform and are therefore unable to devote sufficient time to inspections, and

WHITEAS, The Arizona State Livestock Sanitary Board has offered to pay one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per month of the salary of a joint Tribal and State Livestock Inspector for the Papago reservations,

THEREFORE, Be It Resolved by the Papago Council that Louis Harvey be appointed Tribal Livestock Inspector at a salary of two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per month, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Louis Earvey be recommended to the Arizona State Livestock Sanitary Board for appointment as State Livestock Inspector and peace officer,

PROVIDED: That one hundred dollars (\$100.00) of the calary per month be paid from PT-4 (Farago Tribe, Tribal Salaries) and one hundred dollars (\$100.00) be paid by the State of Arizona, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That Louis Harvey give bond to the Papago Tribe for the faithful performance of his duties in the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) and to the State in the amount required by law,

PROVIDED: That the premium on the bond to the Papago Tribe be paid from PT-3, and

FURTHER PROVIDED: That the premium on the bond to the State be paid by said Louis Marvey.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1949 duly eracted by a vote of 15 for and 0 against, by the Papago Council, pursuant to authority vested in it by Sec. 2 (a) (e) and Sec. 3 (a) of Article V of the Constitution of the Tribe ratified by the tribe on December 12, 1936, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on January 6, 1937, pursuant to Sec. 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934, (48 Stat.984). Said resolution is effective as of the date of its approval by the Superintendent of Papago Agency, and is subject to the rescission by the Secretary of the Interior pursuant to Sec. 6, Art. V, of the Constitution/Dy-laws of the Papago Tribe.
